

Summer Camp Counselor

Job Duties: Under the direction of the Recreation Programmer and Recreation Director, Summer Camp Counselors are responsible for supervising and monitoring campers at all times to ensure a consistently safe and positive environment. Counselors lead a wide range of activities as part of the Summer Playground Program, including sports, arts and crafts, group games, swimming, and chaperoning field trips. They must serve as positive role models, demonstrating exemplary leadership and communication skills while actively engaging with children. Relationship building should be a top priority, achieved through the delivery of fun, inclusive, and meaningful activities that foster connection and teamwork. Counselors are also expected to uphold and represent the mission, purpose, image, and core values of the New Baltimore Parks & Recreation Department in all aspects of their role.

Days/Hours: Counselors work Monday through Friday each week of camp. 2026 camp is 9 weeks long, starting June 8th through August 14th. There is no camp the week of July 4. Counselors will work approximately 35 hours per week, with potential for more.

Applicants **must** be available to work on Saturday, July 11th for the Anchor Bay Triathlon & Saturday, May 30th for camp training.

Qualifications:

- Summer Camp Counselors must be at least 18 years old, Relevant experience working with children preferred.
- Must have a valid Michigan driver's license
- This position requires the capability of leading sports activities, arts and crafts activities, and other general games. The individual must be motivated, energetic, and able to communicate with participants and parents.
- Works well with others and is patient with both children and adults.
- Great communication skills.
- CPR/First Aid certification is preferred
