

## Summer Camp Junior Counselor

**Job Duties:** Under the direction of the Recreation Programmer and Recreation Director, Summer Camp Junior Counselors are responsible for assisting in the supervision and monitoring of campers to ensure a consistently safe and positive environment. Junior Counselors lead a wide range of activities as part of the Summer Playground Program, including sports, arts and crafts, group games, swimming, and chaperoning field trips. They must serve as positive role models, demonstrating exemplary leadership and communication skills while actively engaging with children. Relationship building should be a top priority, achieved through the delivery of fun, inclusive, and meaningful activities that foster connection and teamwork. Junior Counselors are also expected to uphold and represent the mission, purpose, image, and core values of the New Baltimore Parks & Recreation Department in all aspects of their role. This position is an excellent opportunity for teens to develop leadership, communication, and organizational skills in a supervised, hands-on setting. Junior Counselors will receive mentorship from experienced camp staff and feedback throughout the camp season.

**Days/Hours:** Counselors work Monday through Friday each week of camp. 2026 camp is 9 weeks long, starting June 8<sup>th</sup> through August 14<sup>th</sup>. There is no camp the week of July 4. Junior Counselors will work approximately 25 – 30 hours per week.

Applicants **must** be available to work on Saturday, July 11<sup>th</sup> for the Anchor Bay Triathlon & Saturday, May 30<sup>th</sup> for camp training.

### **Qualifications:**

- Summer Camp Junior Counselors must be at least 16 years old and have relevant experience working with children. (babysitting, tutoring, volunteering, etc.) is a plus
- Must be enthusiastic, dependable, and enjoy working with children
- Willingness to learn, take direction, and work as part of a team
- Ability to attend mandatory training and commit to scheduled camp weeks
- Must have a valid Michigan driver's license
- CPR/First Aid certification is preferred
