## A Message From the Mayor



The sunsets coming sooner signal an end to the busy summer nights in New Baltimore, but certainly there is a lot to look forward to. Another successful summer saw events put on by Bay-Rama, the Bay Area Sports Show, Sunsation Power Boats, the NBBA and the Mid-week Music Series and the many events put on by our own Parks & Recreation Department. We would like to extend our sincerest gratitude to all residents who participate in the programs and events put on by Parks & Recreation and other community organizations. We truly could not do it without you and we hope you enjoyed your time with your family and friends.

The change of season does not signal an end to the fun. Throughout this brochure and letter, you will find many great opportunities for you, your family, friends and neighbors to recreate in fun and beneficial ways.

With Labor Day on the doorstep brings back the New Baltimore classic, Art on the Bay – a two-day fine arts & crafts show held within Walter & Mary Burke Park on Labor Day Weekend. Immediately after is the Lions Club car show on September 6 where the park will be filled with plenty of your favorites. The Saturday after is the Amvets Post 52 Blues Festival, headlined by Thornetta Davis. Veterans enter the blues festival free with proof of service. Countryfest returns to Walter & Mary Burke Park on September 20th and 21st, with live music and tons of fun for two days, put on by the NBBA and New Baltimore DDA.

On October 3rd, Downtown New Baltimore gets spooky with the annual Witches Walk and Warlock Stroll, now ran by our very own Parks & Recreation Department. Put on your best witch (or warlock) costume and enjoy the evening in Downtown New Baltimore, with activities ranging from a cackle contest to pumpkin painting and of course, specials at our downtown businesses. Don't forget about the staple Trick-or-Treat on Washington Street on Friday, October 24. Over 50 vendors will be passing out candy to the thousands of trick-or-treaters who flood the downtown streets – visit Parks & Recreation for more information.

Outside of special events, exciting enhancements are moving forward with the harbor project at Walter & Mary Burke Park. City Council has approved a contract with OHM Advisors to move the project to shovel ready status, covered fully by the Senator Kevin Hertel appropriation. Additionally, the City has secured and approved an additional \$500,000.00 from the Michigan DNR Waterways grant program, bringing in 2.5 million dollars of funds available to this project. The team will continue to work through final engineering and permitting processes and will have more exciting news to share soon!

## Where Do I Go For Class?

### Lighthouse Elementary (51880 Washington St.)

- Participants attending classes at Lighthouse Elementary should enter through Door #10 on the West side of the building - across from the bus yard. You will be guided by signage after entering the building.

### Aquatic Center (52401 Ashley St. Door #3)

- Participants should enter through door #3 for classes at the Aquatic Center and check in at the Parks & Recreation desk. Door #3 is on the west side of the building, adjacent to the side parking lot, marked by the blue New Baltimore Parks & Recreation sign.

## Registration and Refund Policies

### Registration Policies

- All registrations must be made more than 2 business days prior to the start date of the class, unless an exception is made by the director.  
(ex. classes starting Monday need to register by the prior Wednesday)
- Adult classes are open to persons age 18 and older, unless otherwise indicated.
- Classes are funded by your fees. Classes that do not meet established minimums will have to be cancelled. **Please register early to avoid cancelled classes! Classes will usually be cancelled the business day before a program starts, and all registered participants will be notified and refunded.**
- The City of New Baltimore and its administration are not responsible for any activities that take place outside of the scheduled practice or class times between the teacher/coach and participants.
- For activities and classes that require waivers, the waiver must be filled out prior to the activity/class beginning.

### General Class Refund Policies

- Participant cancellations made prior to the start of the second class will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Participant cancellations made after the start of the second class will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made at any time due to an emergency will receive a pro-rated refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.
- Cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation will result in participants receiving a full refund.
- Single class cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation due to inclement weather, emergencies, or other circumstances will be rescheduled, if possible.

### Special Event Refund Policies

- This policy includes all one-time events such as races, holiday events, etc.
- Cancellations for special events made 7 days prior to the event will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Cancellations made less than 7 days prior to the events will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made prior to the day of an event/class due to an emergency will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.

### Adult Trips Refund Policies

- Refunds requested within 10 business days of a scheduled trip are not eligible for a refund.
- Refunds requested more than 10 business days of a scheduled trip are eligible for a full refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.

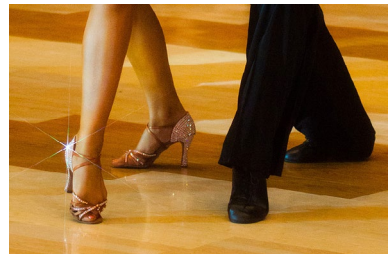
