A Message From the Mayor



While the sun may be fading earlier day by day, the spotlight is bright as ever in New Baltimore! Summer of 2026 brought more energy and entertainment than ever, starting with the Bayview Yacht Club first annual sail race from Detroit to New Baltimore, Anchor Bay Thunder and the expanded programming of the Farmers Market, bringing a special event to Downtown the 2nd Sunday of each month. The work and heart the civic and non-profit groups pour into New Baltimore isn't only special for Downtown, but puts forth effort throughout the city while giving each resident and visitor something to look forward to any given day. The fun doesn't stop after Summer, be sure to check out all of the incredible events New Baltimore has to offer, including the Parks & Rec Witches Walk, Trick-or-Treat on Washington Street and Jingle Bell Run, all of which you can see the details of in the back of this brochure. In addition to these staples, Anchor Bay Countryfest, co-hosted by the Downtown Development Authority (DDA) and the NBBA, bring an exciting two days of entertainment to Walter & Mary Burke Park on September 18th and 19th, headlined on Saturday by Uncle Kracker. These organizations that put on these events not only provide quality entertainment for the community but put resources right back into it. First, we look toward Maynard 'Red' Aurand Memorial Park, where Bay-Rama, INC. donated \$150,000 towards a new playscape. With Parks & Recreation curating a matching grant, the community is receiving an incredible playscape at no cost to the taxpayers. Bay-Rama also agreed to rebuild the park signs at Festival Park with their funds. We salute Bay-Rama for not only what they give back to the community, but for what they offer the community with their programs and events. Be sure to see the Bay-Rama Christmas tree lighting on November 30th.

In the Downtown district, the DDA continues to enhance and beautify the area for your enjoyment. In the Spring, the DDA removed the sidewalk pavers and replaced the pavers with stamped concrete. This provides for an attractive, safe and assessable walk in Downtown New Baltimore for people of all abilities. The DDA also replaced all the street sign posts with decorative posts, a subtle but significant upgrade, ensuring the district continues to preserve the historic values of New Baltimore.

Another exciting update I am pleased to announce is the progress of the Baker building, the former home of Stahl's bakery. A lease has been secured for the first floor and will become New Baltimore's newest restaurant, Stahl's Snug, an Irish pub projected to open in February of 2027. Above that will become two luxury apartments and one standard apartment. We are grateful to see the continued development of the downtown district and welcome Stahl's Snug to New Baltimore!

New Baltimore city services are committed to serving you and continually working to make our community the best it can be. We value your input and encourage residents to share their thoughts and ideas at City Council meetings and commission meetings. All meetings are open to the public, and meeting schedules and agendas are available at www.CityofNewBaltimore.org.

Where Do I Go For Class?

Lighthouse Elementary (51880 Washington St.)

- Participants attending classes at Lighthouse Elementary should enter through Door #10 on the West side of the building - across from the bus yard. You will be guided by signage after entering the building.

Aquatic Center (52401 Ashley St. Door #3)

- Participants should enter through door #3 for classes at the Aquatic Center and check in at the Parks & Recreation desk. Door #3 is on the west side of the building, adjacent to the side parking lot, marked by the blue New Baltimore Parks & Recreation sign.

Registration and Refund Policies

Registration Policies

- All registrations must be made more than 2 business days prior to the start date of the class, unless an exception is made by the director.
(ex. classes starting Monday need to register by the prior Wednesday)
- Adult classes are open to persons age 18 and older, unless otherwise indicated.
- Classes are funded by your fees. Classes that do not meet established minimums will have to be cancelled. **Please register early to avoid cancelled classes! Classes will usually be cancelled the business day before a program starts, and all registered participants will be notified and refunded.**
- The City of New Baltimore and its administration are not responsible for any activities that take place outside of the scheduled practice or class times between the teacher/coach and participants.
- For activities and classes that require waivers, the waiver must be filled out prior to the activity/class beginning.

General Class Refund Policies

- Participant cancellations made prior to the start of the second class will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Participant cancellations made after the start of the second class will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made at any time due to an emergency will receive a pro-rated refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.
- Cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation will result in participants receiving a full refund.
- Single class cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation due to inclement weather, emergencies, or other circumstances will be rescheduled, if possible.

Special Event Refund Policies

- This policy includes all one-time events such as races, holiday events, etc.
- Cancellations for special events made 7 days prior to the event will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Cancellations made less than 7 days prior to the events will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made prior to the day of an event/class due to an emergency will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.

Adult Trips Refund Policies

- Refunds requested within 10 business days of a scheduled trip are not eligible for a refund.
- Refunds requested more than 10 business days of a scheduled trip are eligible for a full refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.

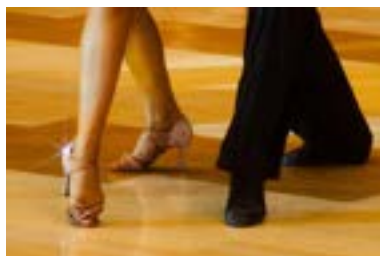

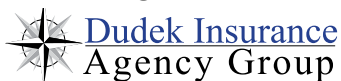
