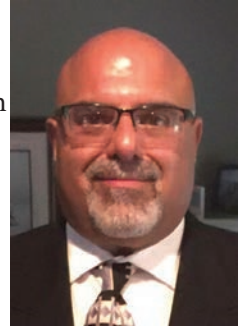

A Message From the Mayor

As the days become longer and the air becomes warmer, we can't help but get excited for Spring and Summer time, enjoyed best on the water front at Walter & Mary Burke Park. Each year, the city works diligently to improve each park and create a better experience for each individual who visits New Baltimore. At Walter & Mary Burke Park, you'll now find things like a chess table, a telescope and fire pits for your leisure. These projects have come to fruition through cooperative partnerships with community organizations, resulting in a more enjoyable time for everyone in our parks.



With continued improvements and enhancements in the downtown area, NBPR is working with local businesses to tailor events downtown, one of which you will see later on in the brochure; a first-time adult only scavenger hunt on May 30th. Additionally, NBPR has agreed to run the Witches Walk in October. I credit the Parks & Recreation department for consistently trying to find ways to engage our residents through different, non-traditional events and look forward to our current and future offerings.

With new events coming into New Baltimore, I would be remised if I didn't mention some of the classics that have become a staple of Summer in New Baltimore. Returning to the lineup this year are Bay-Rama Fishfly Festival, Art on the Bay, Countryfest , Mid-Week Music and others. Also returning for the third year is the Sunstation Street Party on July 31st, bringing back for a second time a free fireworks show for Anchor Bay. The Street Party is once again partnering with the NBPR Bay Area Sports Show, providing live entertainment, family fun, a food truck rally and so much more July 31 – August 2. You don't want to miss out on this unique event.

City Administration has been working diligently on the largest project in recent history for Walter & Mary Burke Park, being the addition of a break wall and potential for expanded docking and utilities on the waterfront. In the Fall of 2024, Senator Kevin Hertel informed New Baltimore Administration that the city was being awarded 2 million dollars from the State of Michigan for an off-shore break wall. We are very excited to move this project forward and will continue to explore grant opportunities to ensure this project succeeds.

Where Do I Go For Class?

Lighthouse Elementary (51880 Washington St.)

- Participants attending classes at Lighthouse Elementary should enter through Door #10 on the West side of the building - across from the bus yard. You will be guided by signage after entering the building and should check in with the Parks & Recreation staff member before beginning your activity.

Aquatic Center (52401 Ashley St.)

- Participants should enter through door #3 for classes at the Aquatic Center and check in at the Parks & Recreation desk. Door #3 is on the west side of the building, adjacent to the side parking lot, marked by the blue New Baltimore Parks & Recreation sign.

Registration and Refund Policies

Registration Policies

- All registrations must be made more than 2 business days prior to the start date of the class, unless an exception is made by the director.
(ex. classes starting Monday need to register by the prior Wednesday)
- Adult classes are open to persons age 18 and older, unless otherwise indicated.
- Classes are funded by your fees. Classes that do not meet established minimums will have to be cancelled. **Please register early to avoid cancelled classes! Classes will usually be cancelled the business day before a program starts, and all registered participants will be notified and refunded.**
- The City of New Baltimore and its administration are not responsible for any activities that take place outside of the scheduled practice or class times between the teacher/coach and participants.
- For activities and classes that require waivers, the waiver must be filled out prior to the activity/class beginning.

General Class Refund Policies

- Participant cancellations made prior to the start of the second class will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Participant cancellations made after the start of the second class will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made at any time due to an emergency will receive a pro-rated refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.
- Cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation will result in participants receiving a full refund.
- Single class cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation due to inclement weather, emergencies, or other circumstances will be rescheduled, if possible.

Special Event Refund Policies

- This policy includes all one-time events such as races, holiday events, dances, or movies in the park.
- Cancellations for special events made 7 days prior to the event will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Cancellations made less than 7 days prior to the events will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made prior to the day of an event/class due to an emergency will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.

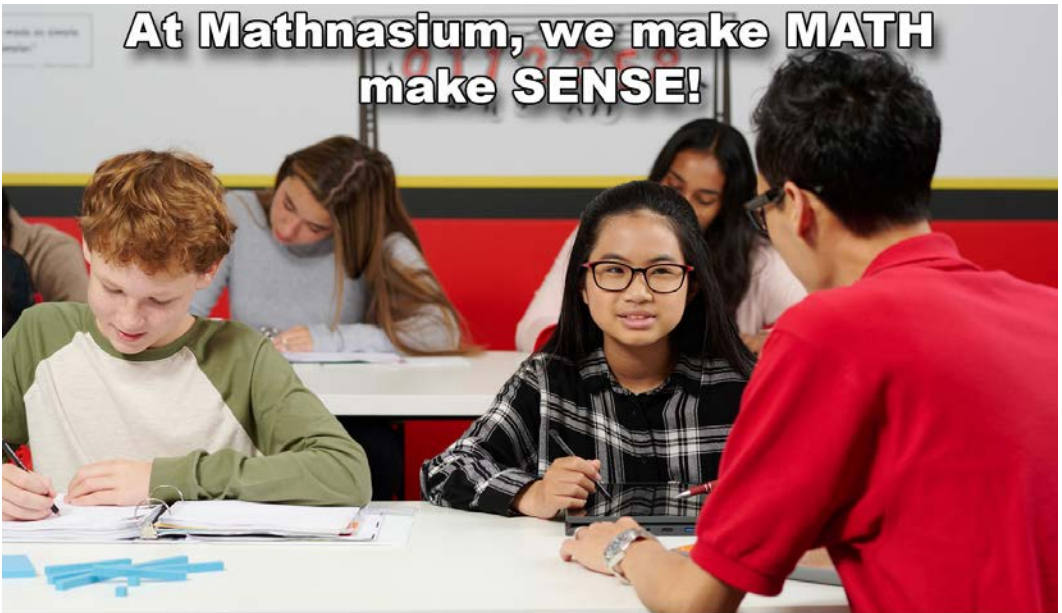

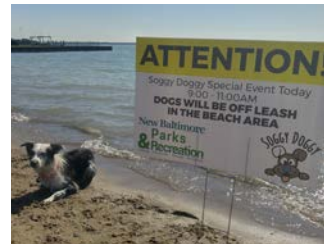

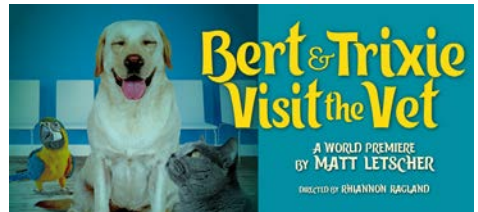
