

A Message From the Mayor

Despite a cold Winter, our sights are set forward to the Spring in beautiful New Baltimore! As the ice thaws, there is always many events for the entire family to enjoy – from the Easter Egg Hunt to Countryfest, New Baltimore has something for everyone. In addition to the events, families can also enjoy leisurely time in one of the New Baltimore parks on the playscapes, athletic fields, grilling or just enjoying a beautiful Lake St. Clair sunset.

With the quality activities and facilities the city offers the Anchor Bay Community, my administration is always striving to improve or create better experiences for you. We are currently spearheading two major projects in New Baltimore. The first is the anticipated Walter & Mary Burke Park harbor project, which is continuing to advance to construction. To date, we have secured 2.75 million dollars in grant funding, with another 1 million dollars currently being advanced through Congress, awaiting final approval. This project will see the strategic placement of a break wall and improvement of docking facilities, creating a safe harbor for boats to visit New Baltimore throughout the boating season. All studies for the project are now complete, and engineering is nearing 90% design plans, as well as preparing for permits from the Army Corps and EGLE. We are anticipating construction to begin this Fall and are incredibly excited for the opportunities this harbor will bring to Anchor Bay.

The other opportunity the city was presented with was to purchase the old Rite-Aid building at 23 Mile Road and Jefferson, which was successfully obtained in the new year. The building, once renovated, will house all current city hall services, such as treasurer, building and all city administrative services. Once that phase is complete, the current city hall building will be revamped to accommodate the Parks & Recreation Department. While the exact details are still being vetted, we anticipate the building will include an activity center for seniors, along with offices for the Parks & Rec Department and staff. The building will also include a much-needed expansion for the Fire Department. We anticipate this improvement will benefit the Fire Department in terms of health, safety and an enhanced facility with dedicated sleeping quarters, decontamination areas and overall improvement.

Lastly, Administration has sought out a grant to assist in replacing the playscape at Maynard 'Red' Aurand Memorial Park. The current playscape has exceeded its useful life and it is difficult to order replacement parts for. The new playscape will have a focus on youth fitness with rising physical challenges for children aged 5-12 years old. We are excited for this opportunity to make another needed community enhancement for everyone to enjoy.

Our city services have and will continue to work for you to enhance the community in the best way possible. Your feedback and conversation are always welcomed at our City Council meetings, as well as any of the commission meetings. All these meetings are open to the public and you can view the schedule and agendas at www.Cityof-newbaltimore.org.

Registration and Refund Policies

Registration Policies

- All registrations must be made more than 2 business days prior to the start date of the class, unless an exception is made by the director.
(ex. classes starting Monday need to register by the prior Wednesday)
- Adult classes are open to persons age 18 and older, unless otherwise indicated.
- Classes are funded by your fees. Classes that do not meet established minimums will have to be cancelled. **Please register early to avoid cancelled classes! Classes will usually be cancelled the business day before a program starts, and all registered participants will be notified and refunded.**
- The City of New Baltimore and its administration are not responsible for any activities that take place outside of the scheduled practice or class times between the teacher/coach and participants.
- For activities and classes that require waivers, the waiver must be filled out prior to the activity/class beginning.

General Class Refund Policies

- Participant cancellations made prior to the start of the second class will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Participant cancellations made after the start of the second class will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made at any time due to an emergency will receive a pro-rated refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.
- Cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation will result in participants receiving a full refund.
- Single class cancellations made by New Baltimore Parks & Recreation due to inclement weather, emergencies, or other circumstances will be rescheduled, if possible.

Special Event Refund Policies

- This policy includes all one-time events such as races, events, etc.
- Cancellations for special events made 7 days prior to the event will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
- Cancellations made less than 7 days prior to the events will not receive a refund.
- Participant cancellations made prior to the day of an event/class due to an emergency will receive a refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee, if approved by the Parks & Recreation Director.
- Bus trips are not refundable within 14 days of the trip date.

Adult Trips Refund Policies

- Refunds requested within 10 business days of a scheduled trip are not eligible for a refund.
- Refunds requested more than 10 business days of a scheduled trip are eligible for a full refund, withholding a \$5 processing fee.
